#### JBO vision

- A single integrated Observatory combining together the LT and e-MERLIN - Jodrell Bank Northern Array ("JBNA"):
  - financial & technical integration (interferometry & phased-up)
  - SKA "compatible" or SKA "compliant".





#### JBO vision

- LT and e-MERLIN technical upgrades fuelled by ongoing SKA R&D developments,
- Increased level of scientific user support, expertise & training,
- Strong and transparent links to the EVN & African VLBI Network,
- Preparing UK community to play a prominent role in the long-term exploitation & support of the SKA.



# Funding (STFC):

- Currently operating within a flat budget environment.
- Ongoing "Balance of Programmes" exercise
- Need to consider alternative, non-traditional funding sources... (e.g. "Global Challenges" - developing countries).

Initial discussions suggest STFC welcome the JBO vision, and understand its strategic importance in terms of UK leadership of the SKA project.
